GRADING SCALE AND ASSESSMENT OF STUDENT PROGRESS

The instructors will assess each student using two major grading categories that are recognized in the Erie County Technical School's Mission Statement:

1. Employability 40%
2. Academic & Technical Skills 60%

Additions

PLACEMENT

Providing work to a student on placement may not be available due to the nature of career and technical education and the restrictions within the placement. Students may be exempt from assignments, provided an alternative task, or be required to make up missed work. A student out on placement (medical or behavioral), may be removed from enrollment from ECTS. An administrative review will determine if a student is considered for re-enrollment during the current or following school year.

ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to "call-off", by contacting their instructor for absences that have not been pre-approved. Each instructor will provide expectations for their call-off policy.

Seniors that have accumulated fifteen (15) or more days of unexcused illegal absences during the year will not be permitted to participate in the senior awards ceremony.
