
High School Activity Report

October 2023

Current Enrollment: As of October 18, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is 826 students. This is an increase of 30 students from the 2022-2023 school year at this time.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 32 students. This is a decrease of 7 students from the 2022-2023 school year at this time.

Faculty Meetings: During the weekly “Mid-Week Meet-Up” meetings, the following topics were discussed: 2024-2025 budget requests, upcoming 9th grade tours, and the Student Performance Measures for teacher evaluations.

In-Service: On October 10th, the faculty conducted their fall Occupational Advisory Committee (OAC) meetings. Instructors hosted their committee meetings during the luncheon to discuss equipment requests, labor market needs, and safety requirements.
