Career Planning

- Introducing all new students to the WIN system and confirming login information.
- Level 2 and Level 3 students are able to continue working individually on required certificates.
- New this year, level one students will be completing certificates using Career Safe program. There are individual topics that can be completed for certification.
- Visits to AM labs are currently being conducted with level 1 students to introduce WIN and allow students to begin working on CEW artifacts.
- **Occupational Objective Forms** have been distributed to those students pursuing Co-op education. All other student Occupational Objective Forms are planning on being completed electronically.
- **Counselor Meeting** held October 6, 2023.

NOCTI

- **NOCTI pre-test** will be administered to four Seniors on October 18, 2023 due to those students being absent/not enrolled at ECTS last spring. All Juniors will take the Pre Nocti March 26, 2024.
