Emergency & Protective Services

The applications for the new program were reviewed and scored. We have scheduled the first Occupational Advisory Committee meeting for January 26, 2024, and are collecting information to share with the committee.

NOCTI Testing

Mary Foulkrod and Sandy are planning for April's NOCTI testing. Junior students will take the pre-test on Tuesday, March 26. Senior will take written tests on Thursday, April 18. Instructors are contacting evaluators for the performance tests scheduled for April 23-25. We have approximately 206 seniors testing this year.

Instructors have received information regarding the NOCTI teacher resource center and are developing plans to prepare students for testing. Both paper and digital study guides will be utilized by the students.

Special Education

Second quarter grade reports for students with disabilities were sent to the special education teachers, case managers and guidance counselors. Sandy and Lesa are communicating with students and parents to develop student success plans as needed. Our instructional aides are working with students on project completion, organization, and portfolio completion.
