Career Planning

- CPC attended the PACTA 2024 Symposium: Pathways to Career Readiness on February 8 & 9, 2024.
- Working with Level 1 students on WIN using the updated Career Comparison and College Comparison rubrics
- Meeting with struggling students to develop Success Plans that can assist students improve grades and attendance through structured plans coordinated with instructors, sending school counselors, and parents.
