Curriculum Development

NOCTI Testing – On March 26, our juniors took the NOCTI pre-test. In total, 304 juniors were tested. On April 18, 200 seniors completed the NOCTI written test. The performance tests is scheduled for April 22-25. We will have approximately 50 volunteers from business and industry evaluating our students. We appreciate the assistance from the sending schools in keeping our sophomores and juniors during the performance testing. Many thanks to our instructors and instructional aides with assisting in the testing process.

Special Education
