May 2024

Current Enrollment: As of May 15, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is operating at 82.7% capacity with 784 students. This is an increase of 22 students from the 2022-2023 school year at this time.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 29 students. This is a decrease of 8 students from the 2022-2023 school year at this time.
