
High School Activity Report

June 2024

Current Enrollment: Concluding the 2023-2024 school year, the Erie County Technical School was operating at 82.7% capacity with 784 students. This is an increase of 22 students from the 2022-2023 school year at this time.

The concluding enrollment for the Transition Center was 29 students. This was an decrease of 8 students from the 2022-2023 school year at this time.

Senior Awards Ceremony: The Senior Awards Ceremony was held on Wednesday, May 29, 2024 at ECTS. The graduating class gathered in four groups to celebrate. SkillsUSA President Kendra Ramey volunteered her time and energy to be our Master of Ceremonies for the evening.
