

**Articulation Agreement Between
Erie County Community College and
Erie County Technical School**

**ECTS Diversified Occupations Program
To
Associate of Applied Business in Management and Entrepreneurial Thinking**

STATEMENT OF COOPERATION

Erie County Community College and Erie County Technical School wish to facilitate the transfer of students, enhance the number and quality of learning options, and provide a seamless transfer process for students at Erie County Technical School who desire further education at Erie County Community College. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT

The articulation agreement applies to students at Erie County Technical School who desire attend Erie County Community College for the Associate of Applied Business in Management and Entrepreneurial Thinking Degree Program. This agreement will also apply to Erie County Technical School students who enroll at the Erie County Community College within five (5) academic years of graduation from Erie County Technical School and provide the appropriate documentation.

The credits outlined below may be awarded to students who:

- Earn a high school diploma
- Earn an Industry-Recognized Certification (OSHA 10-Hour Safety)
- Achieve competent or advanced level on the secondary school end-of-program assessment (NOCTI 21st Century Skills for Workplace Success)
- Achieve a minimum 2.75 grade point average on a 4.0 scale in the Diversified Occupations course.

PROGRAM OF ARTICULATION

Erie County Technical School CTE Program Completers in the Diversified Occupations Course (CIP 32.0105 Job Seeking/Changing Skills (Diversified Occupations)).

Documentation must include the following items:

- High School Diploma
- Official Student Transcript from ECTS
- Copy of Industry-Recognized Credential
- Pennsylvania Certificate of Competency or Pennsylvania Skills Certificate for Diversified Occupations.

Upon meeting the documentation requirements, Erie County Community College will award a maximum of 3 credits of technical electives to the Associate of Applied Business in Management and Entrepreneurial Thinking Degree Program.

ACCEPTANCE OF ARTICULATED CREDITS

The following outlines the acceptance of articulated credits to Erie County Community College:

- A maximum of 3 (three) credits can be received through the articulation process into the Associate of Applied Business in Management and Entrepreneurial Thinking Degree.
- Articulated credits will apply toward graduation requirements for the degree.
- Articulated credits accepted by Erie County Community College will be listed on the student's transcript and credited toward program requirements but will not be included in the computation of the student's quality point average (QPA).
- Articulated credits will be posted after a student enrolls and matriculates at Erie County Community College.

LENGTH OF AGREEMENT

Termination of this agreement may be made by either party and must be in writing. This agreement will be in effect from June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026, however the agreement may be renewed or modified with the written consent of both institutions. Either institution may terminate this agreement by written notice of at least six (6) weeks in advance of the effective date of termination. Should this agreement be terminated, it is understood that the termination will not apply to students already accepted to Erie County Community College under terms of this agreement, and currently enrolled in program classes at Erie County Community College
