

Articulation Agreement
Between
Gannon University
And
Erie County Technical School

Gannon University and Erie County Technical School do hereby enter into the following general articulation agreement to provide students with the opportunity to earn advanced placement credit toward completion of degree programs at Gannon University according to the provisions described herein.

The undersigned educational institutions agree to cooperate in establishing course objectives, requirements, and standards for secondary courses identified within this agreement to ensure that equivalent competencies are achieved. Gannon University will be solely responsible for establishing the requirements necessary to complete its academic programs.

Gannon University agrees to provide and process applications for advanced placement in a timely manner. To be eligible for advanced placement credit, a student must meet all admission requirements in effect at the time of application and be enrolled in a Gannon University program within two years after graduation from Erie County Technical School.

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Gannon University will award academic credit to students who have demonstrated mastery of agreed upon competencies by completing courses identified above with a grade of B or better in each course. Furthermore, the following guidelines shall be observed:

- Credits awarded as a result of this agreement will appear as transfer credits on the student's official transcript. They will count toward completion of the Gannon University program but will not be used to calculate the student's grade point average.
- Students will not be charged tuition or fees for the advanced placement credits earned as a result of this agreement.

In support of this agreement, Gannon University agrees to provide counseling on course of study, career options, and placement statistics. Erie County Technical School agrees to explain the advantages and provisions contained in this agreement to participating students and/or allow Gannon University representatives to explain them.

Gannon University and Erie County Technical School will review periodically the provisions contained in and articulated competencies attached to this articulation agreement.

Gannon University and Erie County Technical School will alter the competencies and/or provisions of this agreement only upon mutual written consent. It is understood that any revisions will not adversely affect students already covered under the provisions of the existing agreement.

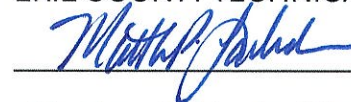
Either party may terminate this agreement upon six months' written notification to the other party. Students in progress will be permitted to complete the program should such termination of the agreement occur.
