Articulation Agreement

Erie County Community College and Erie County Technical Career School

INTRODUCTION

Erie County Community College and the Erie County Technical School agree to establish an articulation agreement for the purpose of eliminating the duplication of instruction for secondary students entering a post-secondary environment. By this agreement, students who have mastered agreed upon competencies at the secondary level may be granted credit by Erie County Community College for equivalent courses. This agreement is based upon the Erie County Technical School curriculum adoption of the Competency Based Program of Study developed by the PA Department of Education or locally approved task list for Career and Technical programs.

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT REQUIREMENTS

Before articulated credits are awarded the following responsibilities must be fulfilled by prospective students:

1. Applicants must meet the standard admission criteria of Erie County Community College.
2. The applicant must have achieved a grade of "C" or better in their career program at Warren County School District and attain an overall high school GPA of 2.0. All articulated credits are subject to the review and approval of Erie County Community College administration. Student high school transcripts will be required.
3. Applicants must complete the enrollment process and enroll at Erie County Community College for credits to be awarded.
4. In lieu of a letter grade, the applicant will receive a different (TR - transfer) grade on their transcript designating that the applicant has received credit for the articulated courses. Students will not receive a letter grade for articulated courses.
5. Articulated credits can make up no more than 50% of a degree or academic certificate.
6. The granting of these credits will be at no cost to the applicant. Students may audit classes where articulated credit has been awarded

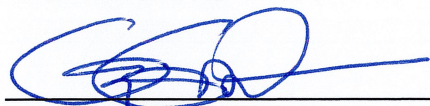
